

'The Workings of Organised Crime', the 61 year-old English resident author insists is his one and only literary endeavour; a man who, other than some holiday reading of PG Wodehouse, admits he hasn't fully read a book since leaving school. He describes in his own words how it seems clear organised gangs have been influencing, and often controlling, our world since the beginning of the 20th Century. He relates how 9/11 was an act of small-minded, vindictive retaliation by the most powerful of those gangs.
